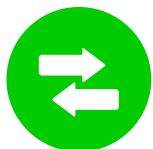

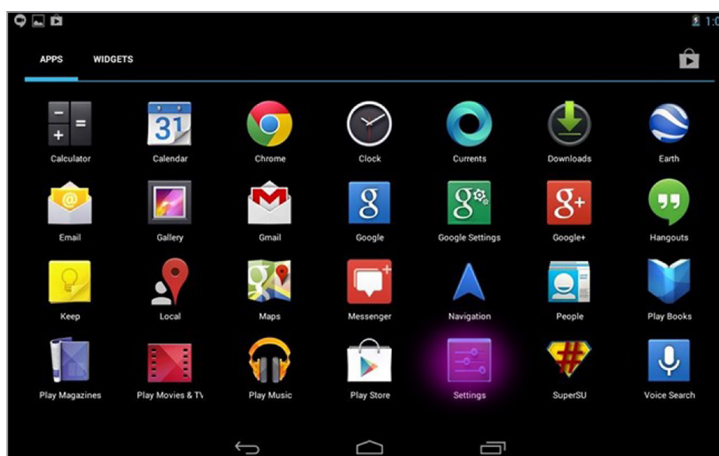

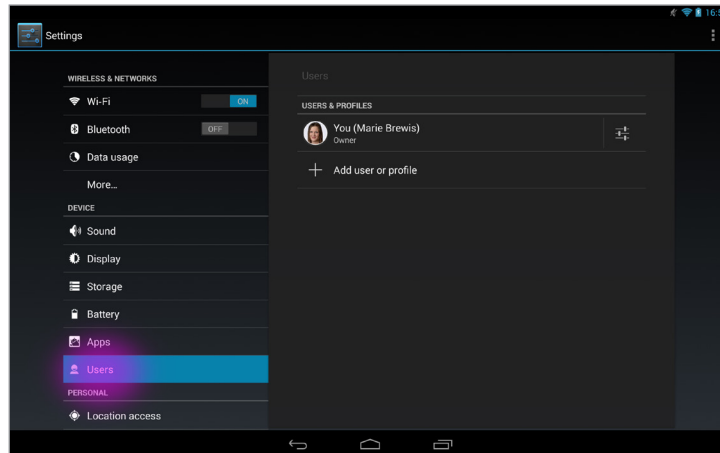
## Step-By-Step

- 1 On the Tablet home screen open up the app menu and select 'Settings'.

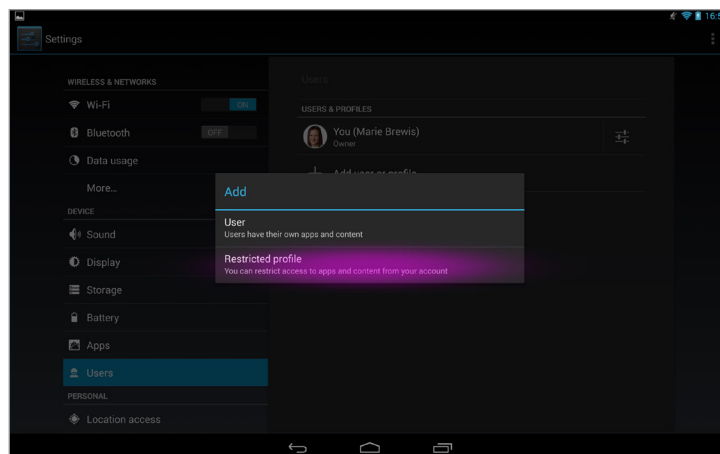




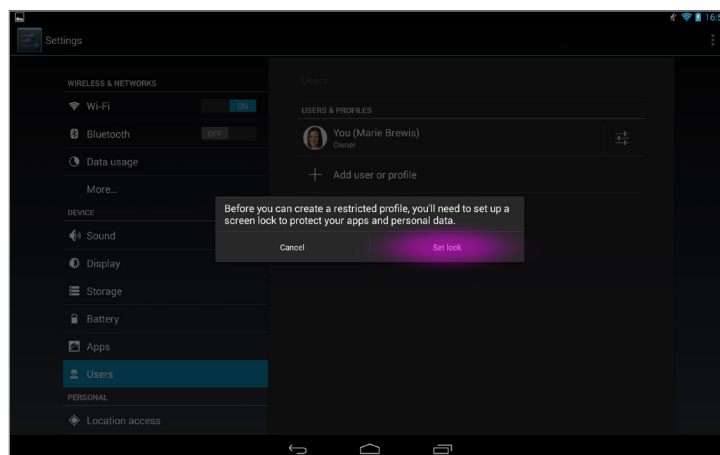
- 2 Scroll down to the 'Device' section and select 'Users', then press 'Add user or profile'.



- 3 Select 'Restricted profile'.

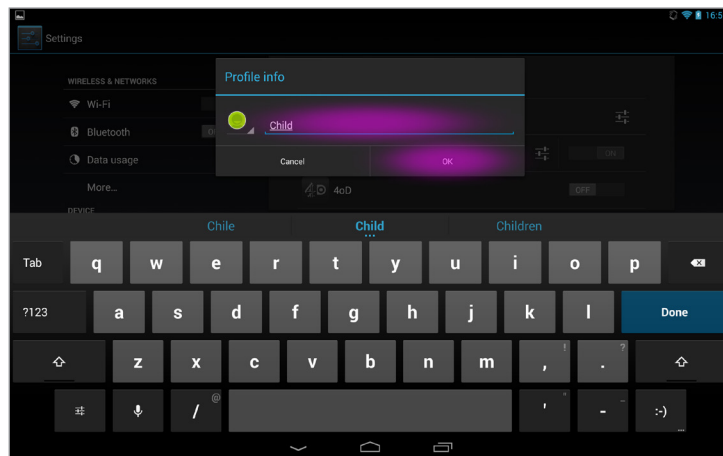


- 4 If you haven't done so already, you'll need to set up a screen lock for your device. Press 'Set lock', then choose to use either a pattern, PIN or password lock.

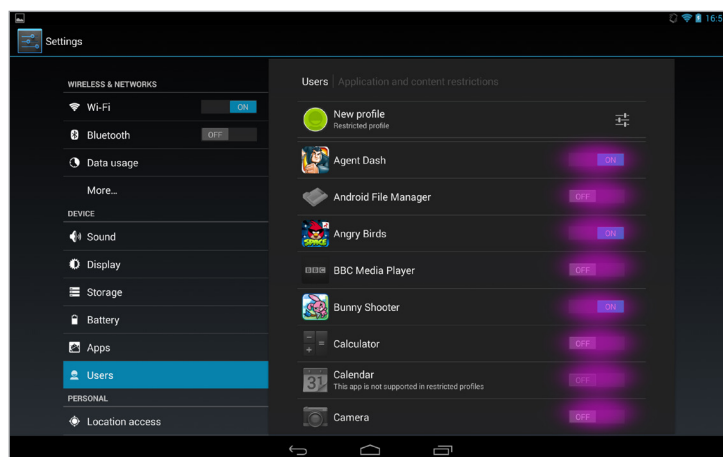




- 5 Press the settings icon next to the 'New profile' to give it a name.



- 6 You'll now see a list of apps installed on your device. By default, the restricted profile is unable to access any of these. Go through the list and toggle the apps you are comfortable with your child accessing.



- 7 From the lock screen, you'll now find your own account is protected with your pattern, password or PIN, while your child can instantly access their own account - but only the apps you selected.
