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what is Forest School?

Forest school is an outdoor, naturebased education approach that focuses on child-led learning in a woodland or natural environment. It encourages hands-on experiences, exploration, and play, fostering children's confidence, creativity, and social skills.

What do we do?

At Portway Junior School , activities in Forest School often include building shelters, learning about nature, and developing practical skills, all while promoting a connection to the natural world.

(What do the children need? 🐂

For forest school, children need clothing that will keep them comfortable and protected in outdoor environments. This typically includes: waterproof clothing, warm layers, long sleeves and trousers and sturdy, waterproof boots or wellies. Dressing in layers helps adjust to changing weather throughout the day.

When is Forest School?

Forest School follows a three-week rotation schedule. You can find the exact dates for your child's class in the year group newsletter or posted on the classroom door. **Please remember** that sessions will take place outdoors, regardless of weather, unless conditions are extreme.
